



Code of Conduct for JKHS Duke of Edinburgh Award
(applies to all training & expeditions on & off site)

All students should:

- observe normal school rules and expectations both on and off site,
- listen to all instructions & safety briefings and act upon these at all times
- cooperate fully and comply with all instructions given by staff, leaders and volunteers
- be punctual,
- regularly attend training sessions, including practice walks & expeditions where appropriate
- be considerate and show respect to others,
- stay with their group throughout the duration of all activities and expeditions,
- abide by the laws, expectations and customs of the places being visited,
- not purchase, carry or consume alcohol, tobacco products or other illegal substances
- not carry any dangerous articles such as fireworks or lasers
- accept that a full written report of any misconduct will be forwarded to the Head teacher and their parents.

Should a student fail to adhere to these expectations, sanctions may be imposed. Depending on the scale of the incident, this could involve the student:

- 1) being removed from the DofE activity and/or expedition, agreed in consultation with a member of senior school staff. In this case, parents/ guardians would be responsible for arranging/ supervising their child's journey home and would be responsible for meeting all costs incurred.
- 2) not being permitted to take further part in the JKHS Duke of Edinburgh Award programme,
